THE FIRST NATIONAL CYBER OLYMPIAD - CYBER CUBE 2016 WAS HELD AT THE RADISSON BLU IVERIA HOTEL



Computer Emergency Response Team of Data Exchange Agency of Ministry of Justice of Georgia CERT.GOV.GE held the first national Cyber Olympiad Cyber Cube 2016 at the Radisson Blu Iveria hotel. The state Security Service of Georgia was a co-organizer. The main goal of the cyber Olympiad was the promotion and

development of cyber-security field, as well as the identification and promotion of talented young people, who possess the technical knowledge and competence.

150 participants under the age 25, who were divided into 50 teams, had been working all day long to reveal and eliminate the cyber incidents of various complexity. Based on the results 3 winner groups had been revealed.

"The idea of the Cyber Olympiad reunited us around a common goal-to promote the preparation of the new generation specialists of information technologies for the cyberattacks crisis situations ,which will increase the level of protection of the country and citizens in this direction."- stated the chairman of Data Exchange Agency, **Irakli Gvenetadze** (Continued on P.2).



(Continued from P.1) As a result of various research and laboratory tasks the participants analyzed and examined 5 different cyber incidents and answered 50 questions (each incident contained 10 questions with varying complexity and weight) and based on the received answers were summarized the final statistics.

"The education and training of young generation is one of the priorities of Data Exchange Agency of ministry of justice of Georgia. Cyber Olympiad will give the students the opportunity to expand their knowledge in the sphere, such as the Cyber security. Nowadays, it is very important to achieve and maintain a high level of cyber security, which of course needs the qualified specialists with skills and knowledge. This is a unique opportunity for young people to represent themselves in mutual competition, and expand their experience"-added **Irakli Gvenetadze**.

The reception of applications for the Cyber Olympiad started on March 9 and continued till April 6. For better introducing the purpose of the event, a number of informational meetings were held with the students from various educational institutions, as well as the special page and channel for online consultation were created at social network.

(Continued from P. 2) Programmers of Data Exchange Agency of the Ministry of Justice of Georgia have created a new mobile application, aimed at raising social awareness about usage and possibilities of open data on the one hand, and showing the importance of the data published on data.gov.ge, on the other hand. In particular, DEA has created a mobile application related to currency exchange offices of Georgia, capable of showing nearby currency shops based on customer's actual location. The application can map over 1000 registered currency exchange offices located throughout the country of Georgia. In addition, this mobile application automatically features all newly opened offices to provide you with the most up-to-date information. Application is based on the dataset provided by the National Bank of Georgia via the Open Data Portal available at: <http://data.gov.ge>.

Open Data Portal, which was created in accordance with the obligation taken within the scope of Open Government Partnership Initiative, is an online resource aiming at increasing accessibility of open data and triggering creation of new e-services based on that data.

The conception of open data occupies special position in both open governance and e-government models. One of the important products in the open data conception is open data portal, which ensures availability of open data published by various public institutions in easily accessible and numerous formats, thus enabling citizens, mass media representatives, governmental and non-governmental organizations to unrestrictedly use the data, as well as various applications and e-services created by utilization of that data.

NATIONAL PUBLIC REGISTRY STARTS TO USE THE INNOVATIVE SECURITY SYSTEM - BLOCKCHAIN



National Agency of Public Registry of Ministry of Justice of Georgia has launched the implementation of the pilot project of the real estate registration with the Blockchain system.

The technical specialists of Blockchain technology company "BitFury Group", arrived in Georgia in April and discussed the basic issues about the project and formation of the first phase, together with the representatives of the Public Registry. Georgia will be one of the first countries, which will use the latest and safest Blockchain system for the registration of real estate.

The appropriate memorandum has already been signed between Public Registry and the BitFury Group.

As a result of the implementation of the project, the process of registration of the property rights will be protected by the latest technology, which will provide the safety, reliability and transparency of the process. Meanwhile the sale and purchase of property will become even more flexible, and the new potential of economic development will appear in the country.

The developed infrastructure of information technologies of the Public Registry and the leading position of the country in Doing Business, defined the partnership interest and desire of the BitFury Group.

It should be noted that the world's most widely used electronic currency Bitcoin uses the same Blockchain system.

Blockchain technology provides its transparency of all transactions, security and flexibility.

MY.GOV.GE PRESENTATION HELD IN MEJVRISKHEVI AND GOMI COMMUNITY CENTERS

Data Exchange Agency of the Ministry of Justice of Georgia has extended its presentation tours and held meetings with residents of Mejvriskhevi (Gori Municipality) and Gomi (Khashuri Municipality), during which advantages of MY.GOV.GE were explained. (Continued from P. 3) Representatives of Data Exchange Agency have given out a very detailed information about Citizen's Portal MY.GOV.GE for the local audience and presented a clear instructions on how to register and use the portal and receive benefit from it.

In order to register on citizen's portal MY.GOV.GE, one can use a new ID card, or username and password, which can be obtained in Public Service Halls (one time visit is required). However, to take advantage of all services provided by citizen's portal it is recommended to use a new ID card.

Citizen's portal MY.GOV.GE is an online resource, which gathers various e-services provided by public and private organizations. The citizen

portal gives user a chance to apply those services remotely, in online regime with a few simple combinations from any country, without having to leave an office or residence.

By going through several simple procedures, the user will be able to use diverse services related with the person (passport, different types of certificates, interesting information about surnames and etc.), property, social services, health, business startup, communal payments, fines, or other types of payments. Each service is grouped in relevant category, which makes it easier to choose the needed ones. The user of citizen's portal can also put all frequently used services in his or her personal page. At this moment citizen's portal displays over 70 e-services.

"The portal is designed for every citizen of our country. That is why it is very important to provide comprehensive information about the system for our customer from different regions of Georgia. We strive to make e-governance, one of the examples of which is e-services and their availability, easily accessible for as many citizens as possible. In this regard, it is important to inform customers residing in regions about these services and today's presentation was a continuation to fulfill this commitment. It is worth noting that the portal will also feature municipal e-services applicable with specific municipalities in the nearest future" – **Irakli Gvenetadze**, DEA Chairman.

The meetings will continue and cover all regions of Georgia.

ONLINE BUSINESS REGISTRATION PROCEDURES ARE BECOMING MORE SIMPLIFIED IN GEORGIA



National Agency Of Public Registry Of Ministry of Justice of Georgia is working on creating the electronic regulations service. This new offer will enable the customers to submit the business registration request with a desirable legal form via the internet, without coming to the public registry.

The model forms of the electronic charter, which were elaborated by the Public Registry and contain all the mandatory data for the registration of business entity, will be available with the appropriate instruction via the internet.

Anyone who has got a desire to register the business, will have the opportunity to register in the program with ID card, after identification they can choose the desired service, fill in the model form of the charter, then confirm the request with the electronic signature and send it electronically with the application registration to the registration statement.

The appropriate instructions will be attached to each field, which will give the detailed explanation to the customers, what information should be placed in each field.

Model registration application / charter will fully correspond to the legislation requirements for the registration. The service will reduce the risk of possible defects to the minimum and will make the service even more effective and accessible for the parties, who are interested in business registration. At this moment the process of electronic functional software providing and processing the technical issues are in progress.
