Data Exchange Agency of the Ministry of Justice of Georgia was visited by the Governmental CERT (Computer Emergency Response Team) representatives of Azerbaijan. Employees of the agency shared information about ongoing projects in Information and Cyber Security to the colleagues from Azerbaijan, as well as experience which CERT.GOV.GE of the Data Exchange Agency accumulated over the past few years.

During the visit, guests from Azerbaijan also met Deputy Minister of Justice, Alexandre Burchuladze.

"We are happy that representatives of different countries are becoming interested in sharing our Agency's experience. Today we introduced to our colleagues from Azerbaijan the methods and means by the help of which we react to cyber incidences, and create and introduce information security policy standards."- said Irakli Gvenetadze, Chairman of the Data Exchange Agency of the Ministry of Justice of Georgia.

Colleagues from Azerbaijan also got known to tendencies towards development of e-governance in Georgia, specifics of e-services, and platform of delivering these services with "one-stop-shopping principle" – Citizen's Portal MY.GOV.GE.



AUTOMATED SYSTEM OF HUMAN RESOURCES MANAGEMENT – EHRMS IS BEING INTRODUCED IN PUBLIC ORGANIZATIONS



"Automated system of Human Resources Management" - eHRMS is actively being introduced in state organizations in the scope of the strategic plan by the LEPL Financial-Analytical Service.

Main priorities of the system are: simplicity and flexibility, which helps users with reducing needed time and resources.

The number of the users of the system is actively increasing. Nowadays this system is already introduced in more than 20 organizations, including in the Administration of Georgia's President; Ministry of Finance of Georgia; Ministry of Culture and Monument Protection of Georgia; The Office of the State Minister of Georgia for Diaspora Issues; Ministry of Internally Displaced Persons from the Occupied Territories, Accommodation and Refugees of Georgia; Government of Adjara; Ministry of Finance and Economics of Adjara; Ministry of Regional Development and Infrastructure of Georgia; Vano Khukhunaishvili Center for effective Governance System and

Territorial Arrangement Reform; South Ossetian Administration; National Statistics Office of Georgia; Civil Aviation Agency; Land Transport Agency; National Forestry Agency; Public Defender's Office; Municipal Development Fund of Georgia.

Financial-Analytical Service continues working on the development of the system, to introduce even more sophisticated product to the users of the system.

DEMAND FOR THE ONLINE NOTARY SERVICES IS INCREASING EVERY YEAR



In 2014, during 6 months, 24 204 notary acts were confirmed with the use of internet in the territory of Georgia. According to the information by the notary office, statistical results about the online completion of notary activities are increasing yearly. 6 390 notary acts were confirmed online in 2010, 25 633 notary acts in 2011, 32 674 notary acts in 2012, and 39 401 notary acts in 2013.

Following notary activities can be carried out online: confirm statement, warrant (power of attorney) from any place; confirm deals (acquisition, mortgages, loan ...

agreements) only from the territory of Georgia.

It is also possible to check meeting protocols of the founders and managing bodies of the entrepreneurial and non- entrepreneurial legal entities, fellowships, and political alliances of the citizens.

Georgia is the only country where notary activities are carried out online. Only citizens of Georgia or people with Georgian residence cards can use online notary services.

The reason why online notary services are so popular is that they can be delivered easily and comfortably. Services are especially popular with the Georgian citizens living abroad. They don't need to go to the consulates and spend extra money and time, instead they can contact any Georgian notary (notary coordinates are displayed on the notary office's website: notary.ge) online (via skype) and get notary service without having to leave their house.

Notary act confirmed via internet is as reliable as the one completed in the notary bureau. Notary has an access to electronic data base of the Georgian citizens and completes notary act only after the citizen connecting to notary is identified. The confirmation process is attended by two witnesses, which also helps in identifying the participant of the notary activity.

GEORGIAN PUPILS SUCCEEDED ON AN INTERNATIONAL OLYMPIAD



On 26th International Olympiad of Informatics (IOI-2014) Georgian team won 1 golden and 2 bronze medals. This year Olympiad was held in Taiwan, on July 13-20.

Team from Georgia was presented by 4 pupils and 2 instructors.

The above mentioned Olympiad is one of the prestigious and large-scale Olympiads on International level. The goal of this Olympiad is to make Informatics popular and support talented students from different countries in sharing scientific and cultural experiences.

Olympiad is held yearly and more than 80 countries participate in it. From year 2005 Ministry of Education and Science of Georgia fully covers the costs related to selecting a team for Georgia, training the team members, and participating in the Olympiad. During this period Georgian team has won 2 gold, 5 silver, and 17 bronze medals.
